

INTENTION TO ADDRESS COUNCIL OR COUNCIL COMMITTEE

The Buller District Council Standing Orders allows members of the public to address both Council and Committee meetings. To make an address, please complete your details in the below form at least 24 hours prior to the commencement of the meeting, and email to governance.assistant@bdc.govt.nz Alternatively, please submit this form to the Buller District Council Offices at 6-8 Brougham Street, Westport or Reefton Visitor and Service Centre, 67-69 Broadway, Reefton.

The Chairperson will call for members of the public to address the Council in accordance with the Standing Orders. The Chairperson will determine the order of speakers to address the Council or Committee.

Each person is restricted to one address of up to five minutes. No more than two speakers can speak on behalf of an organisation during public forum. Where the number of speakers presenting in the public forum exceeds 6 in total the Chairperson has discretion to restrict the speaking time permitted for all presenters.

The Chairperson may comment or question the speaker on the address given or call upon a Councillor or Officer to comment or question.
