Exciting times ahead!

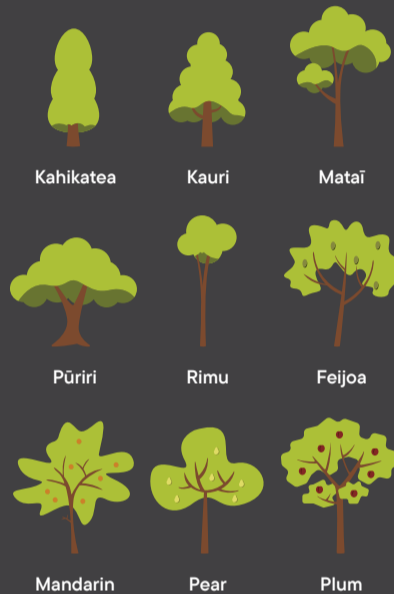
